## 2. Purpose

The purpose of this user guide is to explain in detail how to use and customize the Chart tool in the FlowCentral Studio.

## 3. Charts

Charts is a tool on the FlowCentral platform that allows developers to define a chart.

### 3.1 Creating Charts

This section highlights the step-by-step process involved in creating a new chart.

To create a chart,

- 1. Expand Charts:**

On the side bar that displays the studio components, click on charts to expand charts. A list of actions is displayed allowing the user to either create a new chart or select an existing chart.

- 2. Click on New Chart:**

On clicking this menu, the system opens a blank form that allows users to enter necessary information to create a chart.

- 3. Fill the form:**

This form allows the user to customize a chart. It contains mandatory fields that cannot be left blank.

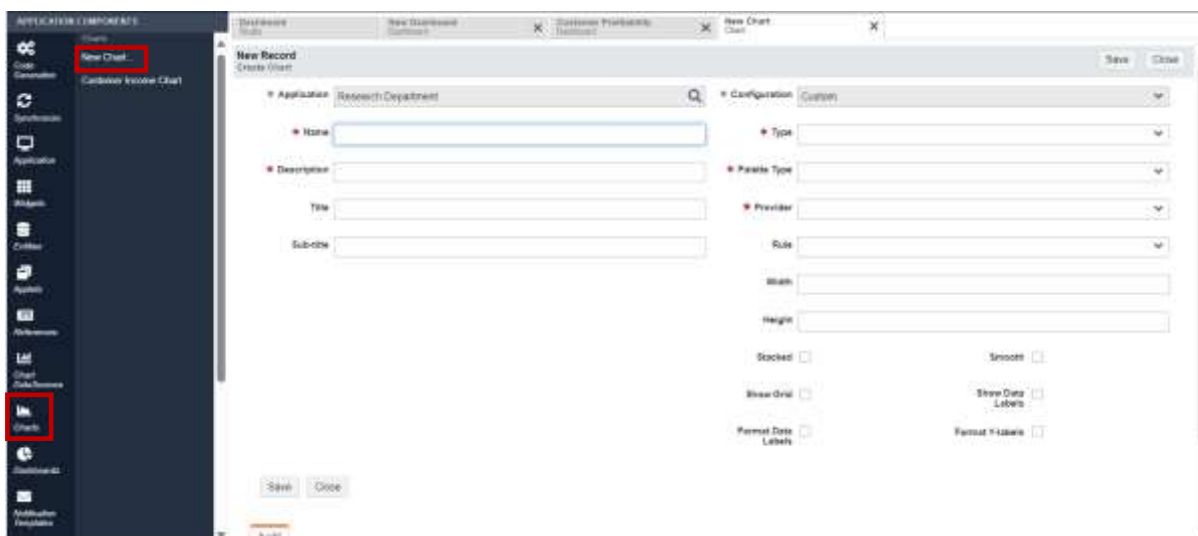


Figure 3.1 Charts

- **Name:** The Name field allows the user to specify a unique name for the chart to be created
- **Description:** This field takes a brief description of the chart to be created
- **Title:** This field is optional. It allows the user to enter a title for the chart
- **Sub-title:** This field is optional. It allows the user to enter a sub-title for the chart
- **Type:** This field allows the user to select a preferred chart type
- **Palette Type:** This field allows the user to select a preferred color scheme for the chart.
- **Provider:** This field allows a user to select components that will provide data for the chart
- **Rule:** This field allows the user to select rules for pooling data based on the selected provider in the provider field
- **Width:** This field allows the user to define the width of the chart in pixel
- **Height:** This field allows the user to define the height of the chart in pixels
- **Stacked:** This field allows the user to customize the categories in the chart.
- **Show Grid:** This option allows the charts to display grids over the chart.
- **Format Data Labels:** This option allows labels to be formatted in the chart.
- **Smooth:** This option defines how smooth the lines in the area or line charts appear.

- **Show Data Labels:** This option allows label display on the chart.
- **Format Y-labels:** This option allows labels on the y-axis to be formatted in the chart

*Note: Any field with the red asterisk \* is a mandatory field. This means that the field is required to be filled before the form can be saved.*

**4. Click on Save:**

After filling the form, the next step is to save the form. To save this form, click on save at the end of the form.
